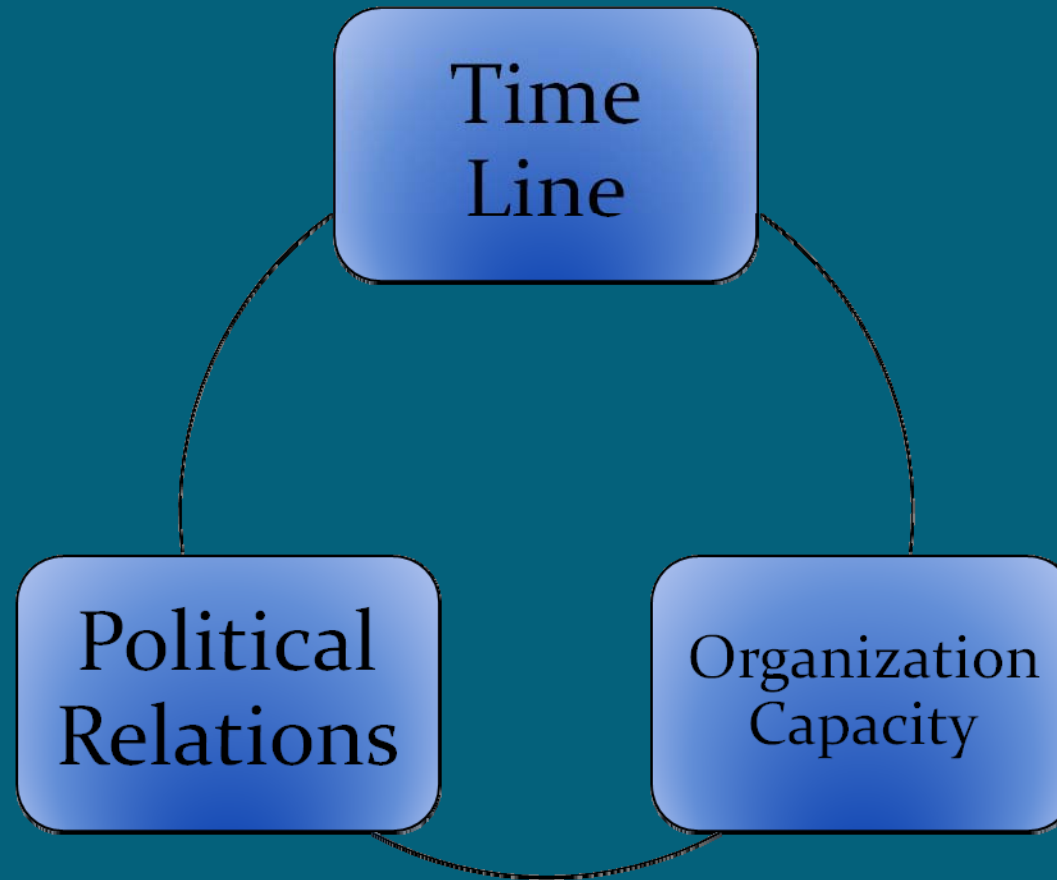

Case Study 1

- Objective: Open a High School
- New-comer English Language Learner Focus
- K-8 Charter in place. Strong Finances and Academics
- Population 98% African American primarily recent Somali immigrants
- District Legal Counsel and Board opposed as they are sensitive to “racially isolated” charter schools.
- Compliant facilities available
- Timing flexible but would like to open ASAP

Case Study 2

- Mid-February Developer Group Coalesces
- Open a K-8 Program that will grow to 450 students
- Constructivist Project Based Ed Model
- “Splinter group” with-in district proposing charter
- Strong charter board and founding group
- Cohesive core of committed teachers and parents
- Must open in coming school year or lose critical mass
- District admin and leadership opposes the charter and has directly requested that the founders not pursue the charter petition.
- Lacking a facility
